Embark on a guided drive through District Six, a historic area located just off the centre of Cape Town, to the south of the Castle. Your tour guide will provide insightful commentary about the

Town, to the south of the Castle. Your tour guide will provide insightful commentary about the district's history. Originally established in 1867, District Six was a vibrant and diverse community comprised of freed slaves, merchants, artisans, labourers, and immigrants.

14:00-16:00 PM: Explore District Six.

During this time, you will have the opportunity to explore District Six further. You can visit the

District Six Museum, which offers exhibitions and displays that provide a deeper understanding of the area's past and the impact of forced removals during the apartheid era.

16:00-17:30 PM: Visit Langa Township.

After exploring District Six, you will head to Langa Township, which is located just east of Table

Mountain. Langa was established in 1927 to provide housing for the workers involved in the construction of Cape Town's harbour. The township was specifically designed to allow authorities maximum visibility and control over its residents.

Upon arrival in Langa, your guide will lead you on a tour of the township. You will have the

opportunity to interact with locals, learn about their daily lives, and gain insights into the challenges and triumphs of the community. The tour may include visits to community centres, local businesses, and cultural sites.

17:30 PM: Return to the pickup/drop off location.

After the Langa Township tour, you will be transported back to the drop off at the CTICC 1 Location

in Cape Town, marking the end of the half-day township tour.
